

## How to complete the attached application.

1. Organize your application in a folder.
2. Page 1 – Title page with the heading “The Kiwanis Club Scholarship Application.” Include your name, High School, home address, phone number and an e-mail.
3. Page 2 – A typed essay of approximately 250 words, answering each prompt.
4. Pages 4-6, the Application.
5. Pages 7-9 – Three letters of reference: one from your civic club sponsor, one from a teacher or guidance counselor, and one from a source outside the high school system.
6. If you have received any press coverage or have had any articles published throughout your high school career, include them after page 9.
7. Send your application to [Kiwanissecretary30@gmail.com](mailto:Kiwanissecretary30@gmail.com) no later than March 30. If your school requires you to submit applications to the Career Center, it is the responsibility of the student to make sure the application was sent.
8. All information in this folder should be typewritten.

## Scholarship Requirements

1. Scholarships will be awarded to a graduating high school seniors based on the following criteria:
  - a. Candidates must be active in at least one civic organization within their high school.
  - b. Candidates must have at least a 3.0 GPA and be in good standing with their high school.
  - c. Candidates must plan to attend an accredited college, vocational or technical school within the United States.
  - d. Candidates must plan to enroll as a full-time student and pursue a trade or certificate program, or attend a two, four, or five year university in the Summer or Fall of the year they are applying for the scholarship.
2. Scholarships will be awarded only to those classified as graduating high school senior.
3. Scholarships will be in the form of funds to cover tuition, books and related course supplies. All scholarship monies will be paid directly to the institution of higher learning at which the recipient enrolls.
